

Anyone else wishing to play or participate, will be required to use the other "open" venues. Starting a club also gives you the only "official" access to HOA distribution channels. Club updates are sent out continuously to all homeowners alerting them of the activities and events a club is hosting, whether that is a charity fundraiser or just a fun day with your friends and neighbors. As a sanctioned Club, you are also given space in the Clubhouse Main Event Room. (Capactiy limits must be enforced.)
